- ▶ Restrictions will not lift quickly.
- ▶ BA / BTAS Webinar with further update.

- ▶ Marketing material is being produced.
- ▶ Concerns over outdoor vs indoor.
- ▶ Governments will be announcing first steps very soon.

BTAS Financial and Staffing Impacts

- ▶ BTAS overall financial impacts.
- ▶ Two major internal objectives: maintain decent financial position and support staff and keep our team together for the re-start.
- ▶ State Government - \$2M allocated.
- ▶ Federal Government - withholding tax credited.
- ▶ Federal Government - stimulus package.
- ▶ Jobkeeper Wage Subsidy.
- ▶ Staff:
 - ▶ 4 week shutdown (using Annual Leave), 1 week back and now either:
 - ▶ Using more annual leave, or
 - ▶ Reduced to 60% load and receiving Jobkeeper.
 - ▶ Staff should be commended for their support of the situation.
