

Basketball in Tasmania participation is inclusive and reaches 20% of Tasmanians annually with a retained membership of 20,000 registered members.

- Define, understand and improve the reach of Basketball in Tasmania.
- Increase the popularity of basketball in Tasmania.
- Increased player registration annually.
- Increased participation by women and girls in basketball programs.
- Increased retention of registered players annually.
  - Increased average total registration period of women and girls annually (length of time in the sport).
- Consistent, high quality delivery of entry level programs state-wide.
- Improved affordability of basketball.
- Breadth of basketball programs and competitions at all levels available state-wide.

#### Our aspiration

Basketball in Tasmania has sufficient quality facilities to meet community and high performance needs and Tasmanians have access to basketball at the level and in the format they desire.

- Develop and promote the Where Can I Play Basketball plan and resources.
- Develop a long term facility strategy for basketball in Tasmania.
  - Audit current indoor and outdoor basketball facilities in Tasmania.
  - Map access to courts against local government demographics, assessing need and capacity.
- Lobby collectively for facility development.
  - Outline and guide organisations in lobbying processes.
  - Create partnerships at all levels of government.
  - Generate entrepreneurial and corporate investment in basketball facilities.
- Progress the Southern multi court facility development in partnership with the Tasmanian Government.
- Improve basketball buy in to facility management of shared basketball infrastructure.

Basketball in Tasmania's coaches and officials are well supported, growing in quality and quantity and recognised nationally for their expertise.

- Develop and implement a coaching and officiating framework for Tasmania.
  - Outline coaching and officiating pathways.
  - Outline coaching officiating targets.
- Increase total accredited coaches to 300.
- Increase total accredited officials to 300.
- Increase the quality of coaching in Tasmania through a rise in the average accreditation level.
- Increase the quality of officiating in Tasmania through a rise in the average officiating accreditation level.
- Resource and expand the provision of training, education and professional development for coaches and officials.
- Recognise and celebrate coaching and officiating excellence.

- Articulate and implement a talent identification framework.
  - Outline the roles and responsibilities of Basketball Tasmania and affiliates in identifying and developing talent.
  - Partner with CAMs to increase talent identification capacity.
- Increase quality of local basketball development programs.
- Increase quantity and overall intake capacity of local basketball development programs.
- Partner with affiliate Coach and Official development programs.
- Increase quality of national event results.
- Support and increase opportunities for the 18-23 year old player demographic.
- Increase retention of development players in the 15-16 year old female demographic.
